What is Project Connect?

• It's a community program that lets qualified students and their families get a free reconditioned computer as long as quantities last. The computer will help students finish assignments at home, and all family members can learn important computer skills. If a family chooses to get Internet service, it helps students and their families get important information via email and the Internet. Your family may purchase Internet service at your expense.

How do you qualify? Your family qualifies if:

- You DO NOT HAVE and CANNOT AFFORD a reliable, Internet-ready computer.
- You reside in Bartholomew County or a family member attends school in Bartholomew County.
- At least one person in your family is enrolled in school (preschool, home school, through college) or your family is part of an educational family support program such as Family School Partners, Head Start, Family Self Sufficiency, Su Casa, and others. Adult students should be aware that the PCs might not meet specifications to run software for some coursework.

How and when do you get a computer?

- Complete the enrollment form on the opposite side. Return it to Tech ReConnect by mail at 1525 14th Street, Columbus, IN 47201 or drop it off in the black locked mailbox at Tech ReConnect (behind Sans Souci).
- Allow at least 10 business days for review of your application. We will call you to tell you if you are eligible. If you are, you may return Monday - Thursday between 10 AM - 4 PM to pick up your computer.
- Bring photo ID with proof of your address and evidence of school/program involvement (a schedule or a note from school office or or teacher/educator, etc.) Be sure to have room in your car for a computer and monitor.

Other information:

- If you have a non-working Project Connect computer, please bring ONLY non-working parts to Tech ReConnect during the times listed above. We'll look at them and repair or replace, depending on the problem. We require up to 10 working days for repair or replacement. We do not provide upgrades for working computers.
